RE: Radon Test Results below 4.0 pCi/L

Dear Radon Customer:

Our records indicate that you have completed a radon test in your home and that those test results came back at a level below 4.0 pCi/L. Radon levels below 4.0 pCi/L do not require further action based on EPA guidelines. However, low levels of radon can still pose a health risk, especially to smokers. EPA suggests that you **consider** fixing your home if levels fall between 2.0 and 4.0 pCi/L. If you would like more information on mitigation (how you fix a home for radon), please feel free to contact me.
