RE: Radon Test Results over 10 pCi/L

Dear Radon Customer:

Our records indicate that you completed a radon test in your home and that those test results came back at a level of 10.0 pCi/L or higher. Whenever a home has a radon level equal to or greater than 10.0 pCi/L, it is recommended that a second short-term test be done to confirm the original test results. If the results of the test are similar, it is recommended that corrective action be taken. The recommended corrective action is to vent the radon out by installing an approved radon system. It is highly recommended that you have a National Environmental Health Association Certified Mitigator install the system for you. A list of mitigation providers will be provided to you after completing the second short term test.

A short term test kit can be purchased from the Polk County Health Department for \$10.00 or one can be mailed directly to you for \$12.00. Please mail a check or money order to the above address and be sure to include your contact information.
